## **Rules & Regulation**

### **General:**

1. **NIMD RANGPEETH** is a drama club formed and run by the students of NIMD.
2. The club meets within the premises of NSHM Knowledge Campus, Kolkata.
3. The primary aim of this club is to enrich the experience of drama in its true form among its members.
4. The club shall meet once a week/twice in a month for workshops by internal faculty or external guest.

### Membership:

1. Students can become a member of RANGPEETH by paying a registration (one time) fee of Rs. 20/- (Rupees Twenty Only).
2. To continue being members of the club, students have to pay a monthly subscription fee of Rs. 20/- (Rupees Twenty Only).
3. A receipt, signed by the faculty-in-charge, will be issued for any kind of payments made to the club.
4. The monthly subscription fee has to be submitted by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of each month.
5. Failing to submit the subscription fees before the above mentioned period consecutively for two (2) months will lead to cancellation of the membership.
6. Members will have to carry their RANGPEETH ID card for the meetings and the workshops of the club.

### Code of Conduct in Workshops & Otherwise:

1. Members have free access to all of the workshops that are organized by the club.
2. Non-members can also attend the workshops by paying an entry fee of Rs. 15/- (Rupees Fifteen Only) per workshop.
3. Mobile phones are either to be switched off or kept on silent during workshops. Violators will be immediately asked to leave the workshop premises. Other behavioral issues/conflicts will allow the Governing Body to cancel membership of the candidate from the drama club.
