### Brief introduction of the speakers:

**Prof. Anupam Basu** is presently a Professor at Department of Computer Science Engineering in IIT Kharagpur. Previously he has taught at University of California, Irvine and University of Guelph, Ontario, Canada as a visiting Professor and has been the Humboldt Fellow at TU Dortmund, Germany.

He teaches Computer Architecture, Operating Systems and Embedded Systems at IIT in addition to Artificial Intelligence, Intelligent Systems and Cognitive Science courses. His research interests include Embedded Systems, Natural Language Processing, Assistive Technology, Natural Interface Design, Human Computer Interaction. He has a long list of publications and awards credited to him.

**Prof. Amlan Chakrabarty** is presently Associate Professor at Department of Computer Science Engineering in University of Calcutta. He has completed his research in ISI, Kolkata and done his post doctoral research in MIT and Princeton University.

He teaches Computer Architecture, VLSI Design and Embedded Systems in C.U. and his research interests include Embedded Systems, Image Processing and VLSI Design and Human Computer Interaction. He has a long list of publications and awards apart from serving as editor in a number of prestigious international journals.
