RULES FOR POETRY WRITING COMPETITION

- A poem should be max of 25 lines.
 - Additional description, if necessary, can be given about the poem (Line limit – 10).
 - The entry file name should be in the format for poetry – (CLC PCT2021 -your name, eg. CLC PCT2021 – Amit Kumar).
 - The Entries in Ms- Word file format should be uploaded in the folder link mentioned in the Registration form.
 - Entries can be of any theme, in any of the three languages (English, Hindi, Bengali)
 - Mention your- Name, Course with Semester, College Email-id, Contact Number.

RULES FOR ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION:

- Topic of the essay writing event is **Business Idea VS. Entrepreneurship**
 - Participants should send in their entries by 26.09.21. They should upload the essays in the folder link in the google form.
 - Medium for writing is English
 - Maximum Word limit is 500 words.
 - Essay shall be presented preferably in multiple paragraphs.
 - Participants' write-ups will be judged based on the content and style of writing.
 - Judges' decisions in all respects will be treated as final and will be binding on the participants.
 - Participation certificates shall be given to all the students participating in the events.

RULES FOR PHOTOGRAPHY

- **Theme: Visions of rural future**, we would like the participants to explore their vision of rural future in sectors of employment, SHG's, women empowerment, improvement in technology in terms of agriculture, agrarian innovations, sanitation, etc. Participants' vision of a rural future should be both comprehensive and harmonious.
 - Each participant can submit a maximum of one entry.
 - Photographs uploaded must be at least 800 pixels on the larger side. The size of the photograph should not exceed 5 MB.
 - The entry may be accompanied by a caption (Maximum 10 Words)
 - File Name of the entry should be: PY_theme_Participant name_Programe_Semester
 - The photograph should be an original picture clicked by the participant. The organizers cannot be held responsible for copyright violation, malpractice, misrepresentation made by any of the participants.
 - Photograph's EXIF data should be intact and should include the date and time on which it was clicked and also the model of camera it was clicked with.
 - Entries should be sent in digital form without borders, watermarks, copyright marks or identifying the mark on the photograph
 - By participating in the competition, entrants agree to allow the organizers to use their photographs, in print or electronic form, for non-commercial purposes.
 - The organizers' decision shall be final and binding. They maintain the right to disqualify any entry for violating any of the above rules.

RULES FOR JUST A MINUTE

- It's an individual talent competition
 - The total Performance time is 2 minutes
 - Participants are free to expose any talent
As long as it is presentable and does not require props.

RULES FOR ELOCUTION COMPETITION

- Elocution competition will be conducted in the 'Block & Tackle' mode.
 - Each participant will have to speak for & against the motion; when the moderator says 'Block' the participant needs to start speaking against the topic and needs to continue to speak till the moderator reverses the motion saying 'Tackle', the participant then needs to switch and start speaking for the motion.
 - Each speaker will get three minutes to speak including both the 'block' & 'tackle' rounds.
 - The topic(s) of the elocution competition will be announced an hour before the start of the event.
 - Only English can be used as the medium.
 - Mobiles or any other gadgets cannot be used during the conduct of the event.
 - Contestants will be judged on the basis of content & delivery
 - Judges' decisions in all respects will be treated as final and will be binding on the participants.
 - This is an individual event and multiple participants from an institution / batch / course allowed.
 - This is a live event and to be conducted online; participants would be required to be on video-on mode during the event.

RULES FOR SPORTS QUIZ:

- Sports quiz is an individual event; multiple entries from a single batch/course allowed.

- It is a live event and will be conducted online; participants would be required to be on video-on mode during the event.
- The quiz competition will be conducted in three rounds – preliminary round, semi-final & final.
- The preliminary round will be conducted involving all the registered participants from which first 12 (twelve) participants will qualify for the semi-final round.
- The semi-final round will be conducted with the first 12 (twelve) qualifying participants from the preliminary round from which first 6 (six) participants will qualify for the final round.
- The final round will be conducted with the first 6 (six) qualifying participants from the semi-final round and the winner and the runner-up will be awarded.
- The number of qualifying participants in the preliminary and semi-final round may vary depending upon the number of registrations; the decision of the judges' panel during the event will stand final.
- Questions will be asked to participants one by one.
- Each participant will get 20 (twenty) seconds to answer the question in the preliminary and the semi-final rounds while in the final round time limit will be 15 (fifteen) seconds.
- 5 (five) points will be awarded for each correct answer in the preliminary and the semi-final rounds while in the final round 10 (ten) points will be awarded for each correct answer.
- There is no negative marking for incorrect answer and no 'pass on' option; each unanswered or incorrectly answered question may be answered by any willing participant but no bonus points will be awarded.
- Each of the rounds i.e. preliminary, semi-final & final round will include three sub-rounds namely: '*World*', '*India*' & '*Audio-Visual*' round.
- No request for alteration / change of question will be entertained.
- If any participant is found to be adopting any unfair means for answering the questions during the event, his/her participation will be cancelled.
- Judges' decisions in all respects will be treated as final and will be binding on the participants.
