

PAPER SUBMISSION – IMPORTANT DATES



 All works of the authors should be original and should not have been previously published or under review with any other academic publication.

Abstract:

- An extended and factual abstract is needed (300 500 words). Informative abstracts and critical abstracts are accepted.
- The abstract should state briefly the purpose of the research, the scope of the study, methodology, the principal results/analysis and major conclusions. An abstract is often presented separately from the article, so it must be able to stand alone.
- \checkmark The abstract should be submitted in the format of MS Word (.doc or .docx) document.
- \checkmark The document must be in double space format using Times New Roman 12-point font size.
- ✓ The submission should contain: The title, name (s) of the author (s), affiliation (s), and e-mail address of each author.

Final Paper:

- \checkmark The final papers should not exceed 8000 words excluding references.
- Please submit tables as editable text and not as images. Tables can be placed either next to the relevant text in the article, or on separate page(s) at the end.
- Please make sure that artwork files are in an acceptable format (TIFF (or JPEG), EPS (or PDF), or MS Office files) and with the correct resolution.
- \checkmark The document must be in double space format using Times New Roman 12-point font size.
- Based on the reviewer's comments, the organizing committee will take one of the following decisions: - accept without revisions, accept with minor revision, accept with major revision, non-acceptance.

Dr. Gary Graham

Associate Professor in Operations and Supply Chain Management, Leeds University Business School

Dr. Gary Graham did his PhD in the area of Defence Industry Structure and Supplier Strategies from the University of Huddersfield. Working at present in the Leeds University Business School, Dr. Graham has been previously associated with University of Manchester. He was also a visiting scholar in University of Cambridge, Massachusetts Institute for Technology, University of North Carolina. He's a co-director with Prof. Chee Wong of the Centre for Operations and Supply Chains. Dr. Gary is Associate Editor of International Journal of Operations and Production Management and special issue editor in journals like Supply Chain Management: An International Journal, Annals of Operations Research, and Operations Management Research. He is in the Editorial Board of Member of Supply Chain Management – an International Journal Journal and Sustainability. In 2013, Graham was awarded an EPSRC Digital Economy funded scholarship to work with Prof. Chris Caplice and colleagues at the Centre for Transport and Logistics at the Massachusetts Institute for Technology in Boston on future freight modelling in the US. He is currently working on projects like YHAHSN and NHS supported project investigating the impact of misinformation on public behaviour with respect to COVID-19, ESRC project investigating the impact of Brexit and automation on supply chain labour shortages and the skills requirements for warehousing and logistics workers in the UK, with the North East Automotive Alliance on the electrification of the auto industry supply chain and the supporting infrastructural role played by Sunderland Council and the local LEP.
